



EODSA Player Fine Collection Policy

August 2019

It is important that fines issued to players through discipline are paid because they are part of the discipline decision against the player. As players are not members of the EODSA, the EODSA must work with Clubs in order to collect unpaid fines.

Any player fine not paid by the end of the season will be invoiced to the player's Club. Until the player makes a payment to the EODSA in the amount of the fine:

- (i) the player is suspended;
- (ii) the player's name will be listed on the EODSA website; and
- (iii) the player may not register with a Club or team.

If the player pays the fine (to the EODSA), the Club that had been invoiced shall be reimbursed by the EODSA and any suspensions will be lifted.
